How it happened THE FIRST CRUSADE

In 1054 The Great Schism splits the Christian church into East (Orthodox) and West (Roman Catholic).

Between 632 and 1090 Islam expanded rapidly and conquered most of the Christian Byzantine Empire.







In 1093 Byzantine Emperor Alexius I writes a letter to Pope Urban II in which he asks for military aid against the Seljuk Turks. Pope Urban II reads the letter and decides to give a speech (1095) in which he calls Catholics to go help the Byzantine (Orthodox) Christians.





On Friday, July 15th 1099 Jerusalem was reconquered by the Crusader armies.




Some Jewish communities in Europe were harassed by Crusading soldiers who were enroute to Jerusalem.
